## PARISH PARTICIPATION PROGRAM

- This program will began August 28, 2021.
- St. Helen Church will supply your family with a booklet of attendance vouchers. These will be distributed at the school orientation nights. If you are unable to attend, please stop by the parish office to obtain your vouchers. Your parish ID and family roster are included in this packet. Please make sure we have your current contact information on file. If you need to update your family information please call Laura Lewis at the parish office, 772-567-5129 or email LLewis@sthelenvero.org.
- Additional voucher books are available at the Church office.
- In the event you forget your voucher while attending Mass, we will have extras available at the front doors to the Church.
- The active Catholic discount will be applied to the extent that you choose to participate at Mass and fulfill service hours which will be applied on a prorate basis to the School Year 2023 / 2024.
- To assist clergy in getting to know your family better, it is your responsibility to physically hand your voucher to a priest or deacon after Mass at St. Helen Church.
- Be sure your voucher is filled out completely with your family name, address, date, and parish ID.
- Please DO NOT place your attendance voucher in the collection basket. Offertory and special collection envelopes are handled separately.
- We understand that your family may travel out of the area during the year or may become ill, so there will be an allowance of 8 weekend / Solemn Feast Day obligations that you can fulfill at another Catholic Church while you are away or ill.
- Attending a Mass during the week does not count as fulfilling your Sunday obligation and Holy Days of Obligation.

Our Weekend Mass Times
Saturdays at 4 p.m. (English) or 7 p.m. (Spanish)
Sundays at 7:15 a.m., 8:45 a.m., 10:30 a.m., 12:15 p.m. & 5 p.m.

Our Holy Days of Obligation Mass times are the same as above.

On some Holy Days there may be an additional Mass.

## PARISH PARTICIPATION PROGRAM

- As a parishioner of St. Helen, you will be expected to be involved in Church ministry. We are
  asking that each parent and student in 4<sup>th</sup> grade or higher participate or volunteer one hour per
  month in a ministry or church event. This is in addition to the St. Helen School volunteer
  requirements.
- Please obtain a copy of the St. Helen Parish Handbook which lists numerous opportunities to provide service. Special events are listed on the Church website and in our weekly bulletin.
- Hours can be combined such that 4 hours of service fulfills the expectation of 4 months.
- Volunteering for the Harvest Festival will count towards **school hours only**.
- It is your responsibility to track your Church volunteer hours in RenWeb/FACTS. There are several Church options in the drop-down box menu, please choose one of the options for your Church volunteer hours and then explain which event / ministry you participated in the Notes field. It will be the responsibility of the parent to record student volunteer hours.

## **How to Log Volunteer Hours - RenWeb**

All volunteer hours should be logged and recorded within your own individual RenWeb/FACTS account. To submit hours:

- 1. Go to www.StHelenSchoolVero.org and click on RenWeb|FACTS OR www.RenWeb.com.
- 2. Log in to your ParentsWeb account.
- 3. District Code: shc-fl.
- 4. Click on the "Family Information" tab from the left-menu options.
- 5. To the right of that box is a list of family members. Click on the person performing the service hours.
- 6. Locate the "Service Hours" tab to the right of "Contact Information". Click this tab.
- 7. Record your volunteer hours by clicking "Add Service Hours". Enter the date of service hours, description of work, number of hours, notes, and a St. Helen Parish priest, deacon or staff member or chairperson who can verify your work. Press SAVE.
