PARISH PARTICIPATION PROGRAM 2022/2023

- This program began August 28, 2021.
- If you are a registered parishioner of St. Helen and have a student attending St. Anastasia Catholic School or John Carroll High School, you participate in this program. Each enrollment year registered families complete a Parish Affiliation form and have it signed by the pastor. If our records indicate that you have not been participating in this program by turning in a Mass voucher, the pastor will not sign your form.
- The subsidized tuition rate is applicable upon receipt of the Parish Affiliation Form. New families must have a letter from their previous Catholic Church confirming registration (for first year only) to obtain the pastor's signature on the Parish Affiliation form.
- It is imperative that you turn in your Mass voucher each week. If your attendance falls below 80%, the pastor will not sign your Parish Affiliation form.
- When you apply for the 2023 / 2024 school year the pastor will sign your form if you have attended 80% or more Masses from August 2022 through December 2022.
- We track your Mass attendance through our voucher program. We do not track through offertory due to online giving and donations received by mail. Offertory donations are not indicative of Mass attendance.
- St. Helen Church will supply your family with a booklet of attendance vouchers. Your parish ID and family roster is in this packet. Please make sure we have your current contact information on file. If you need to update your family information please call Laura Lewis at the parish office, 772-567-5129 or email LLewis@sthelenvero.org.
- To assist clergy in getting to know your family better, it is your responsibility to physically hand your voucher to a priest or deacon after Mass at St. Helen Church.
- Be sure your voucher is filled out completely with your name, address, date, and parish ID.
- Please DO NOT place your voucher in the collection basket. Offertory and special collection envelopes are handled separately.
- In the event you forget your voucher while attending Mass, we will have extras available at the doors to the Church. Additional voucher books are available at the Church office.
- Attending a Mass during the week does not count as fulfilling your Sunday obligation and Holy Days of Obligation.
- As a parishioner of St. Helen, you should be involved in Church ministry. We are asking that each parent and student in fourth grade or higher participate or volunteer one hour per month in a ministry or by attending a church event.
- Our Parish Handbook is available online and each ministry of St. Helen has a page on our website www.sthelenvero.org. Special events are listed on the Church website and in our weekly bulletin.
- Hours can be tallied such that 4 hours of service fulfills the expectation of 4 months.
